DIRECTIONS TO SHOW

From I-75 take Dryden Road Exit-50A.

At the end of the exit ramp, turn West onto Dryden Road and go to the Traffic light (see Holiday Inn) Turn left onto Arbor Boulevard and proceed until it ends into River Road. Turn left onto River Road and proceed approximately seven-tenths of a mile (Passing Mandalay Banquet Center) Orbit Industrial Park building is the last building on the left just before the pond. Turn left into parking lot and go to the right-back side of the building.

Attention Exhibitors

The show site will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 a.m. each morning. Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Obedience classes that use jumps will be run in ascending jump height order beginning with dogs that jump 4". Please remember to enter your dog's jump height on the entry form.

Move ups will be allowed for this trial. All move ups will run at the end of their class. Please help the trial secretary by submitting your move-up by October 15, 2010. Move ups must be submitted using the move up form, which can be found on the AKC website (akc.org). Move ups will not be accepted after 7:30 a.m. on the day of the trial.

Judging procedure may be modified to accommodate disabled handlers.

All dogs must be kept on leash or crated at all times, except as allowed in the show ring. Please exercise your dog in the designated areas. Please clean up after your dog.

Crates may be left inside the show facility overnight in designated areas. Space will be available outdoors for tents and crating. Exhibitor X-pens will be permitted in certain areas outside of the building. Pens must not block entrance or exit of doorways or use prime parking areas. X-pens are not allowed in the building.

No entry can be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form. Unsigned checks and returned checks do not constitute payment of fees. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received prior to the close of entries. DDTC will not be responsible for errors made on entries. Please double check entry prior to sending. Owners are responsible for errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable after entries close. An identification card for each dog and Judging Program will be e-mailed (or mailed) to all exhibitors.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. These fees are to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only.

Entries fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be returned if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of Dayton Dog Training Club.

DDTC assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Trial Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All awards must be claimed the day of the show – None will be mailed. Unclaimed prizes become the property of DDTC.

Snacks, beverages, and lunches will be available at the show site for purchase. Also, there are fast-food restaurants near the show site.

No smoking is allowed in the DDTC building. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on show grounds or in parking areas.

DDTC does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for these events.

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best or Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list if the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the A.K.C. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
