Entry fees:

\$50.00 for TD Test, (includes AKC recording fee). With the entry form for a dog that has not passed an AKC Tracking Test, there must be a written statement, (certification), dated within one (1) year and signed by a person approved by AKC to judge a Tracking Test, certifying the dog has performed a Certification Test similar to an AKC Tracking Test.

\$100 for TDX Test, (includes AKC recording fee). All dogs entering the TDX Test must hold the TD title from AKC.

Entry Fee Refund: Those who decline being placed on the alternate list shall have their entry fee returned. If for any reason a dog making the draw cannot run, the entry fee will be refunded PROVIDED an alternate competes in their place.

Bitches in season will be allowed to participate. Notify the Test Secretary if your bitch is in season for special instructions.

Entries of AKC TD dogs in the TD Test and of AKC TDX dogs in the TDX Test will be accepted only in the event the Tests have not been filled by dogs which have not yet passed an AKC TD Tracking Test or TDX Tracking Test.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best or Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list if the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. The TD Test will start after the draw when ready, Sunday, April 18, 2010. TD exhibitors are required to be present for the drawing of tracks at 7:30 a.m. EST. **The TDX Test** will start after the draw when ready, Sunday, April 18, 2010. TDX exhibitors are required to be present for the drawing of tracks at 9:30 a.m. EST. **Both draws will be held at Test Headquarters** in Sycamore State Park at the Overlook Shelter off Providence Road.

Notice: Exhibitors shall be required to sign a waiver releasing Maple Glen Farm and its employees, the State of Ohio Department of Natural Resources and their employees, and the Dayton Dog Training Club, Inc. from liability for any injury or risk before participation in the Test on park and/or farm grounds. A copy of the waiver will be available at the Test Sites. This is a State law and will be enforced.

Alternate Entries: When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to Ch. 1, Sec. 13, shall be assigned a position on the Alternate List corresponding to the order in which they are drawn. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the Test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if any alternates are present and decide according to their previously assigned position on the Alternate List which of such entries shall participate. If TD entries do not fill, TD tracks can be converted to TDX tracks at the rate of 2 unfilled TD tracks to 1 TDX tracks, or 1 TDX track converted to 2 TD tracks.

Awards: Dayton Dog Training Club, inc. will present a suitable award at a later date to each entrant successfully passing these tests.

DIRECTIONS TO TEST HEADQUARTERS

From the East: Take I-70 West to State Route 49 N (EXIT #24) – Note: SR 49 South is 3 miles before SR North exit). Immediately after exiting, take the first right and go 2 blocks to the first stop sign – DIAMOND MILL ROAD. Turn right on Diamond Mill Rd., go over I-70 and go South until you pass the Park Office on the right. The first right past the Park Office is PROVIDENCE ROAD – turn right onto Providence Road and go to the picnic Area on the left. Test Headquarters will be in the Picnic shelter area.

From the North or South: take I-75 to I-70 West and follow the directions “From the East.”

From the West: take I-70 East to State Route 49 (EXIT #24). Turn left from the exit ramp. Go straight through two stop signs. Turn right at the third stop sign on to DIAMOND MILL ROAD. Follow the above directions, “From the East,” to Test Headquarters
