## AKC News

The requirements for registering a litter resulting from artificial insemination using fresh extended semen were modified, removing the requirement that the extraction be done by a veterinarian.

The Chinook will be eligible to compete in the Miscellaneous Class at shows starting June 30, 2010. The Icelandic Sheepdog will be eligible for AKC registration on June 1, 2010 and to compete in the Herding Group June 30, 2010. The Cane Corso & the Leonberger will be eligible for AKC registration on June 1, 2010 and to compete in the Working group June 30, 2010.

Effective March 1, 2010, dogs competing in Earthdog Events will be able to earn an Earthdog Endurance Title (EE). It would be awarded when a dog, on five occasions, passes both the Senior and Master Test at the same event.

There were a number of changes to the Agility Regulations, regarding the use of Jump Height Cards.

### Obedience Director of Training Report for November 2009

As always – a big thank you to all of my instructors and assistants. Also a big thank you to Richard Eppley for keeping the obedience info on the website up to date, to Fred and Terry McCarty for their phone work, to Barbara Mann for the roster and registration work and to my training committee for all their work and support.

The Late Fall 2009 Session is under way. The following classes were cancelled due to lack of students – Beginning Obedience Competition and Canine Good Citizen. Most of the remaining classes have a fair amount of students in them.

We have decided to cancel CGC class indefinitely. Instead we will be holding CGC certifications the last Thursday of the Early Fall and Spring sessions every year. Details will be posted to the website, yahoo group, and in Clublicity when they are finalized.

We have replaced the BOC class this session with a Problem Solving Open/Utility class with Doug Scott. A member can sign up for a 15 minute time slot (subject to change to 10 minutes) to work on a specific problem(s) or learn a new exercise. Current Instructors will have preference. Details are on the building post just outside the ring.

We have instituted the AKC STAR puppy program in our puppy classes. Now we have to incorporate it into our other classes that have dogs less than one year of age. What we will now be doing is: The AKC STAR puppy program will be explained the first night of class and the brochures handed out. We will also be explaining about the \$10.00 fee that AKC charges to participate. The students then will let the instructors know by the fourth week if they want to participate in the program. I need this information to line up the appropriate number of AKC CGC certified evaluators that will be needed the last night of class to do the STAR puppy testing.

The club needs more AKC CGC certified evaluators. We may have as many as 40 to 50 puppies testing at the end of each session and we will need more people to do the testing. (sign-up sheet to be handed out).

When we have to refer someone to private training, we will be giving them a Private Referral Handout. Currently we will be listing following: Kandy Robinson, Diane Carr, Carrie Hensley, Loren Lorenzo, and Positive Pet Solutions. If you know of any other reputable trainer that would take on reactive, timid, or aggressive dogs please email me the information.

We need more instructors and assistants. This session I have 6 instructors that are currently teaching or assisting in two classes. That just leads to instructor burn out. If you see someone you think might be a good instructor please talk to that person and invite them to assist or let a training committee member know. We usually start someone off with a puppy class. I do not have a large enough pool of instructors to draw from. It is not up to me alone to find every one of them. I am not generally even here on Tuesdays. I have already given the board notice that if we are unable to somehow create a larger instructor pool, I will no longer be Obedience DOT after the summer 2010 session. That part of the job is just too hard.

Winter session is always difficult. I already know of some instructors that will not be available. I need anyone that can teach to please sign up. (sign-up sheet for next session to be handed out)
