AKC News

Obedience regulations were amended, effective January 1 2010, to allow a dog to be moved from the "A" class to the "B" class, at the same level, based on the dog or h&ler, not being eligible to compete in the "A" class.

The AKC Board approved a new conformation title "Gr& Champion", for dogs & bitches who have completed their Championship.

AKC News continued

The Large Gazehound Racing Association was added to the list of organizations with non-AKC events that may be held by AKC clubs.

Effective 1 January 2010, all FSS enrolled dogs with 3 generation pedigrees will be eligible to compete in all AKC Companion Events.

Effective 1 January 2010, a new FAST title was added to the Agility regulations. The addition of this title is to encourage exhibitors to continue exhibiting their dogs past the Master FAST titles & to help clubs increase their agility entries.

Numerous changes, effective 1 January 2010, were made to the tracking regulations, as recommended by the Tracking Advisory Committee.
