Congratulations, you and your dog(s) are entered in the DDTC January Agility Trials. You will find a copy of your dog's information for the January 27, 28, and 29, 2012 DDTC Agility Trial on a separate page attached in the email of this letter. Please read this carefully and make sure your dog's name(s) and registration number(s) are correct and that it is entered in the proper classes. Exhibitor's who marked their entry form "My dog needs measured" will need to pick up their running sticker at the score table once you have been measured. All other dogs will be in the self-registration books.

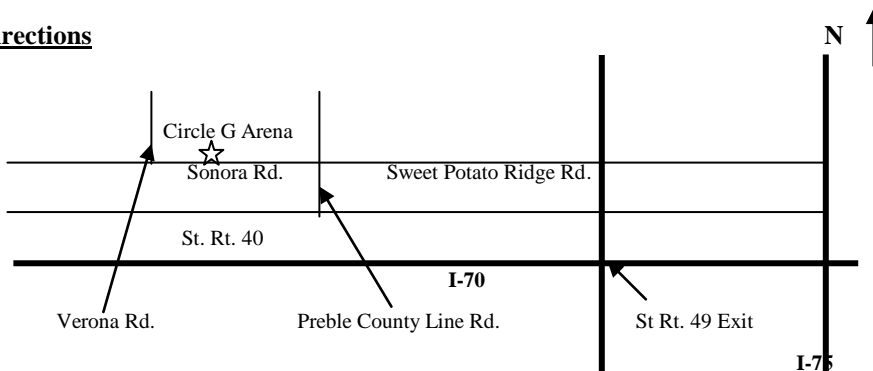
We are fortunate to have judge, Tom Slattery, as VMO all 3 days, and Dave Mancino, as VMO on Saturday and Sunday. In accordance with AKC regulations, all dogs that do not have a permanent or valid temporary Jump Height Card issued by the AKC shall be measured by a judge of record prior to competing. **Measuring will be held at the discretion of the judges and their availability during the day.** Any dog with an **expired** jump height card and any dog **without** a jump height card **must be measured** before you can run your dog.

## PLEASE NOTE:

Volunteers who are willing to set up rings, unload equipment, and help with general set up etc., will be allowed to set up their crating on Thursday evening between 4:00 and 7:00 PM. If you arrive during this time you **must** be willing to help out. There is plenty of crating space available for all exhibitors. Crating space for everyone will be available to all at 8:00 AM Friday morning.

## Directions



Take I-70 to Rt. 49, North on Rt. 49 to Rt. 40 West (left at stop light) stay on Rt. 40 about 6 miles to Preble County line Road and turn right, go about 2 miles to the second road on the left - Sonora Road. (Note this is Sweet Potato Ridge Road on the East side of County Line Road) turn left on Sonora Road. The entrance to Circle G Arena is on the right off of Sonora Rd.

You are, of course, expected to clean up after your dog. There will be equipment and supplies to do so located at several places around the arena.

## General Running Order

**All classes will run SMALL TO TALL all three days.** (4", 8", 12", 16", 20", 24", 26") Within a jump height; the B dogs will run, then the A dogs (Excellent and Novice), and then the Preferred dogs. **We will walk 4,8,12, run, walk 16, run, walk 20, run, walk 24-26, run, for Excellent classes only all 3 days.** Due to the large 20" classes for Excellent on Saturday only, they may be divided at the judge's discretion for the walk thru. **Novice, Open and all FAST** classes will be walked all together for each class.

**Friday and Saturday's judging** of class runs will begin with Excellent FAST at **9:00 a.m.** Briefing and walk-thru at **8:45a.m.** Excellent STD will then follow FAST and Open STD, then Novice STD.

Judging of the **Novice FAST** class will begin at **10:00 a.m.** Briefing and walk-thru at **9:45 a.m.** Open FAST will follow then Novice JWW, Open JWW, and Excellent JWW.

**Sunday start times will be 8:00 a.m., briefing at 7:45 a.m.** for the STD ring starting with EX STD, then Open STD, then Novice STD. **9:00 a.m. start time, briefing at 8:45a.m.** for JWW ring starting with Novice JWW, then Open JWW, then EX JWW. Walk-thrus will remain the same as previous days.

**Please remember that dogs must be on lead at all times inside and outside while on the trial grounds.**
