- Incomplete or Illegible entries are not acceptable. Entries will not be accepted without fees and/or signatures.
- Please waive signature if sending via mail.
- A fee of \$30.00 will be charged for all returned checks.
- Catalogs will not be available for sale at the trial. You may pre-order a catalog for \$6.00 by marking the entry form and including payment.

REFUNDS

- Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with a bitch entered that is in season on the trial date will be refunded the entry fee for that bitch. Written/mailed notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary not later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class of the trial.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be returned if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of Dayton Dog Training Club. DDTC does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for these events.
- Overpayment of fees by \$10.00 and less will be considered as a donation to the club and no refund will be issued.
- Owners are responsible for errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable upon receipt in an e-mail. Shortly after closing, emails containing all entry information, and show information will also be sent.

TRANSFERS

Transfers will be allowed for this trial. Please refer to the rules and regulations, Chapter 1 General Regulations, Section 16a and 16b. Transfers must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

RINGS AND CRATING

- The Rally ring is 40' x 50'.
- Rally, Beginner Novice and Novice Rings are matted with high-quality rolled rubber matting. Open and Utility rings have $\frac{3}{4}$ " artificial turf.
- Please place protective floor covering under crates. Crates must not block entrance or exit or doorways.
- No food other than water and dog treats are permitted in the turf room.
- Crates may be left overnight in the building. No dogs are allowed to remain overnight or without human supervision.
- Exercise pens are not allowed indoors.

RENT A RING

A Rent a Ring will be held at Dayton Dog Training Club on Thursday October 15th. Details will be sent with final confirmation.

INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

- Rally and Obedience classes that use jumps will be run in ascending jump height order. Please remember to enter your dog's jump height on the entry form.
- DDTC assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- All dogs must be kept on leash or crated, except when in the ring.
- Please exercise your dog in the designated areas and clean up after your dog.
- The show site will be available to exhibitors one hour before the start of the first class.
- Exhibitors are responsible for having their dogs at the ring gate. Judges are not required to wait on dogs or handlers.
- Food will be available for all attending this event.
- No smoking or vaping is allowed in the DDTC building. No alcoholic beverages allowed on show grounds or in parking areas.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be refunded.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW

Coming from the North on I-75: I-75 South to Exit 51 for Edwin C Moses Blvd/Nickols Road. Turn right off the ramp. Drive past Love's Truck Stop, under the railroad bridge (and the light at Washington St just on the other side) and at the next light, turn left onto Dryden Rd heading South. At the next light, turn right onto East River Rd. Travel approximately 1 mile and DDTC will be on the left at the South End of the Orbit Industrial Park.

Coming from the South on I-75: North on I-75 to exit 47, the West Carrollton exit. Turn right off the ramp. Go to the first light and turn left. You are now on Dryden Rd. Go straight through the first light you come to and watch for the third left turn lane; just past the end of the Heidelberg Distributing building. Turn left. You are now on East River Rd. Go over the bridge and travel approximately 3/4 mile and DDTC is the first building on the right, past the lake. You should see the DDTC sign on the right.
