# LEVEL 1/2 FOUNDATION with CONTACTS and WEAVES

Prerequisite: Must have completed 1 Obedience class. Or by Director of Agility Permission For students who need a daytime class Class will need to be repeated to move on

- Introduce basic agility skills using different obstacles/contacts at lower heights
- Focus and attention to moving on from obstacle to obstacle

#### LEVEL 2 INTRODUCTION TO CONTACTS AND WEAVES

Prerequisite: Level 1 A & B AND Instructor Permission

- Introduction to 12 weaves
- Contract performance with 2 on 2 off method at lower heights
- Dogs will work on and off leash

#### WEAVE FOR BEGINNERS

Prerequisite: Must complete Levels 1 AND 2

- Continue weave work with 12 weave poles
- Work on weave entrances
- This class may be taken with an additional class
- This class will be for 45 minutes
- OFFERED WEDNESDAY NIGHTS AT 5:15 PM

#### LEVEL 3 INTRODUCTION TO AGILITY

Prerequisite: Level 2 AND Instructor Permission

- Introduction to additional agility equipment
- Teams begin short sequences
- Reinforcement on attention/focus working mostly off leash
- Continue with weave performance
- OFFERED TUESDAY NIGHTS AT 6:30 PM

# FUN FOR AGILITY

Prerequisite: Must complete Level 1, 2 and 3 agility classes and work off leash

- No formal training/instruction provided unless it is for safety issues
- This class is NOT intended for handlers/dogs who plan on competing in agility
- Perfect for those wishing to play with their dogs without the stress of competition
- Courses will be short sequences that include tunnels, jumps set low, 6 weaves and lowered contacts

# LEVEL 3/4/5

Prerequisite: Must have completed Level 1 & 2 <u>AND</u> Instructor Permission For students who need a daytime class Class will need to be repeated to move on

- Strengthen 2 on 2 off contacts
- Introduce lead changes with sequences
- Will be working off leash

#### LEVEL 4 SKILLS AND HANDLING

Prerequisite: Level 3 AND Instructor Permission

- Continued work on basic handling skills
- Improving contact performance
- Longer sequences introducing different crosses and side changes
- Continue to improve weave performance

# LEVEL 5 PRE-NOVICE

Prerequisite: Level 4 AND Instructor Permission. Must be able to weave 6 straight poles

- Teams will continue to build on improving contact and weave performance
- Sequences requiring more advanced handling skills
- All work off leash
- OFFERED WEDNESDAY NIGHTS AT 6:30 PM

# LEVEL 5/6 PRE-NOVICE/NOVICE

Prerequisite: Level 4 <u>AND</u> Instructor Permission. For students who need a daytime class

- Teams will continue to build on improving contact and weave performance
- Sequences requiring more advanced handling skills
- All work off leash
- OFFERED WEDNESDAY AFTERNOONS AT 12:30 PM

#### LEVEL 6 NOVICE

Prerequisite: Level 5 AND Instructor Permission. Must be able to weave 12 straight poles

- Sequences become more advanced with distance work and good understanding of side changes
- Working on novice courses
- OFFERED MONDAY NIGHTS AT 5:15 PM
- OFFERED MONDAY NIGHTS AT 7:45 PM

# LEVEL 6/7 NOVICE/OPEN

Prerequisite: Level 5 or competing at this level For students who need a daytime class

- Sequences become more advanced with distance work and good understanding of side changes
- Understanding course analysis the best pathway for your dog
- All work off leash

#### LEVEL 7 OPEN/EXCELLENT

Prerequisite: Level 6 or competing at this level
